In Colorado and At Philmont Base Camp

Look Sharp and Proudly Show Our BSA and Patriots' Path Colors!

You know from the "Uniform Fact Sheet" in your *Crew Member Guide* that a full, Official BSA (Class A) Uniform, with no "look-alikes" or exceptions, is required to be worn while traveling and throughout the Colorado Tour. That includes:

Official BSA (Class A) Uniform

BSA shirt with Patriots' Path Council Philmont expedition patch BSA belt BSA pants: short, long, or switchback ... your choice BSA socks: short or long ... your choice Boots ... the boots you intend to hike in at Philmont Hat ... good sun protection hat required - crew design optional Neckerchief ... not required but crew design is appropriate

After arrival at Philmont, a change to a BSA Activity (Class B) Uniform is appropriate, substituting your Watchu Base Camp Gear T-shirt for your uniform shirt. Put that T-shirt on under your uniform shirt the morning you are travelling to Philmont. As soon as your Ranger takes you to your trailbound tent, with a quick change removing the uniform shirt you are in a Class B uniform and will be on your way to complete all the Day 1 check-in activities.

That evening, another quick change to put the uniform shirt on again has you back in a Class A uniform and ready for dinner, the religious services, and the Opening Campfire.
