## Watchu Passport Requirements

- Crew Roster: Make sure the Crew Roster is up to date at the Philmont Gateway (print out a copy from the Philmont Camping Gateway).
- **BSA Registration & Uniform:** All members of your crew must be registered as members of the Boy Scouts of America with uniform and be in possession of a BSA registration card when traveling. BSA Registration Cards will be checked. Also Watchu CSP sewn on left shoulder.
- Watchu Wilderness Pledge: All members of your crew must sign the Watchu Wilderness Pledge. The form with original signatures is to be submitted to the Watchu Administrator.
- Youth Protection: All members of your crew 18 years of age or older must have completed the most current National BSA "Youth Protection Program". All advisors must be in possession of a Youth Protection Certification Card. Youth Protection Certificates will be checked.
- CPR: Your crew must meet the Philmont requirement for CPR. At least two crew members must be certified and Chief Watchu strongly recommends all crew members to be CPR certified.
- Wilderness First Aid: Your crew must meet the Philmont requirement for and Wilderness First Aid certification. As listed in the Council and Unit Planning Guide, Philmont requires at least two crew members certified in WFA be with the crew at all times in the backcountry. Chief Watchu strongly recommends that at least three members of your crew be certified in Wilderness First Aid, the others certified in Standard First Aid. Certification cards for those members who qualify will be checked.
- Weather Hazard Training: At least one advisor, and preferably all, must have a valid Weather Hazard training certification. Certification cards for those members who qualify will be checked.
- Swim Test / Safe Swim Defense / Safety Afloat: To participate in the whitewater rafting trip during the Colorado Tour, each crew member, both youth and advisors, must pass the BSA swim test. At least one advisor, and preferably all, must have a valid Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat certifications. Certification cards for those members who qualify will be checked.
- Airline Ticketing Information Form: The form (in Word document format) must be submitted by e-mail to the Watchu Administrator.
- Photo Identification: All members of your crew should have a government issued Photo ID for air travel to
  and from Colorado. This requirement is an absolute for adults, while crew members 17 years old and younger
  can get by with two forms of identification other than a photo ID. However, to make things go without a
  hitch Chief Watchu strongly advises all to carry picture identification. The Lead Advisor initials the Passport
  when this requirement has been completed for each crew member.
- BSA Health and Medical Record: All members of your crew must have a fully completed and signed BSA
  "Annual Health and Medical Record," including a copy of the crew member's medical insurance card. No
  substitutes will be accepted. The document must be signed by physician and crew member, and by a guardian
  for youths. All Medical Records will be collected at Watchu Mountain Adventure Check-In, and returned at
  the end of the weekend.
- Rafting Permission / Release Form: Each crew member, both youth and advisors, who will be whitewater rafting must complete (parents or guardians complete for youth) the on-line Rafting Permission / Release Form (or paper release form, if applicable). Lead Advisors will be provided a link to share with their crew families to complete the on-line form.
- Colorado Tour (Blue Sky Adventures) Release Form: All members of your crew must have a completed and signed release form (on line or paper, as required) for their Colorado tour operator. Youth members must also have the signatures of guardians.
